- Worked closely with the Police and other agencies to identify and tackle crime and anti social behaviour

- Carried out walkabouts to improve untidy gardens
- Supported residents to engage with agencies who can provide support

- You feel outdoor and community spaces could be cleaner and better maintained.
- You would like a stronger Police presence in the community.

- Improvements could be made to the cleanliness of communal areas and neighbourhoods.
- Whitleigh is a large community and although it is out of the city centre, there are good transport links.



What are we going to do?

Tackle fly tipping and waste management issues

Why?

To give residents pride in where they live.

How?

We'll work with our environmental team to look at improving communal bin areas and installing CCTV in areas where there is fly tipping. We'll also speak with Plymouth City Council about getting more bins and street cleans.

When?

Continue to work with residents to ensure gardens are kept clean & tidy

Why?

To improve the environment for residents.

How?

Continue neighbourhood walkabouts and work with residents to try and find solutions to keep their gardens maintained.

When?

Improve communal areas

Why?

To ensure residents are able to enjoy communal areas

How?

We will tackle fly tipping and carry out regular walkabouts and work with our asset management team to improve stairwells and the exterior of building.

Request a greater Police presence

Why?

To ensure residents continue to feel safe with the community.

How?

We will meet with our local neighbourhood Police team to explore options for increased visibility and support.
